### Ruminations from the Pastoral Pasture

New beginnings! Fresh starts! I always loved the beginning of a new school year: new books, new schedules, new teachers-everything new! Of course, life is filled with lots of new beginnings: birth, graduation, and marriage being the biggies. And retirement, as I'm really feeling it approach. For you: a new pastor, soon! And, if you "drill down," each new day is a new beginning. God is up to something new here. Welcome it!

Throughout the Bible, especially obvious in the psalms, there is a threefold pattern of (1) orientation, (2) dislocation, and (3) new orientation. That is, first we had the way things are, then something happens that upsets that normal, and then, we find ourselves in a "new normal." That is, we do not return to the way things were, instead, we get a new beginning. We need to mourn the loss of the "old normal," but some of us get stuck there, and never get around to welcoming the new normal, the new beginning. Behold, here is a new beginning, a fresh start: live into it!
